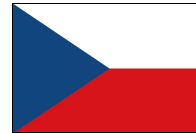

Prague (English pronunciation: /ˈprɑːg/ Czech *Praha*) is the [capital](#) and the [largest city](#) of the [Czech Republic](#). Situated on the River [Vltava](#) in central [Bohemia](#), Prague has been the political, cultural, and economic centre of the Czech state for more than [1100](#) years. For many decades during the [Gothic](#) and [Renaissance](#) eras, Prague was the seat of two [Holy Roman Emperors](#) and thus was also the capital of the [Holy Roman Empire](#). Today, the city is home to more than 1.2 million people, while its [metropolitan area](#) is estimated to have a population of over 1.9 million. Since 1992, the extensive historic centre of Prague has been included in the [UNESCO](#) list of [World Heritage Sites](#). Prague has lots of nicknames some of them are "the mother of cities" (*Praga mater urbium*, or "Praha matka měst" in Czech), "city of a hundred [spires](#)" and "the golden city".
